

# Running Unimus behind a reverse proxy

Please note this article describes running Unimus behind a **reverse proxy**.

Unimus fully supports running behind reverse proxies, both Apache and nginx.

## Example nginx configuration

    proxy_http_version 1.1;

    proxy_send_timeout 30m;
    send_timeout 5m;

    proxy_cache off;
    proxy_buffering off;
